A plan was then presented by the committee.

Motion made & carried that the plan presented by the committee be accepted & they be instructed to build a school house after said plans & they be authorized to make changes in the dimensions of

said building if they deem it necessary.

Meeting then adjourned Aug. 15th, 1889 at the same time and place.

Resolved that the Trustee be & is hereby authorized to levy a tax of \$200.00 on the District & to issue Bonds against said Dist. to the amount of \$1200. in addition thereto for the purpose of building a new school house. Said Bonds to be of the denomination of \$150. each & to bear interest at 6%. Said Bonds to become due on the 1st day of Oct. each year or at annual periods payable at the 1st National Bank of Rondout, N.Y. with the interest on the whole amount until paid. The 1st Bond due Oct. 1st, 1890. The following are the names of those who voted on the above resolution:

Motion made & carried that the trustee & building committee be authorized to drain the lot & build the foundation for said school house according to their best judgment & also build suitable water closets for school purposes on said lot.

Annual School Meeting held in school house at 7:30 P.M. in Dist. No. 19, Town of Roxbury. The following business transacted.

Meeting called to order at 7:30. **A.L. Baker** chosen chairman and **S. N. Murphy**, Secy. Trustee's

report on finances was then read, accepted and adopted as read.

It was then moved and seconded that the Sec. cast one unanimous vote for **Willis Cronk** for Trustee. Motion cast.

Upon motion **Samuel Harley** and **D.S. Booth** were named as tellers and they together with the Chairman and Secy took the constitutional oath of offices. A formal ballot was then taken for Trustee which resulted as follows. Whole number of ballots cast 38, of which **Frank Cronk** received 26 and **Willis Cronk** 12. **Frank Cronk** declared duly elected.

Upon motion the clerk was instructed to cast one ballot for **A.L. Baker** for Dist. Clerk. The formal ballot for Collector resulted as follows. Whole number of votes cast 34 of which **Harrison Cronk** received 22, **O.C. Haynes** 9 and **J. _ Wright** 3. **Harrison Cronk** declared duly elected collector.

On motion of **O.C. Haynes** it was decided to charge outside pupils two dollars each per term for attending school.
